Northeast Ohio Veterans Have Opportunities at Hiring Fair

COLUMBUS – Northeast Ohio veterans, active military and spouses can get themselves and their skills noticed by local public and private employers at the “Hiring Our Heroes” hiring fair hosted by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and local partners June 29 at the Wolstein Center at Cleveland State University.

The fair will be held from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. The Wolstein Center is located at: 2000 Prospect Ave E , Cleveland, OH 44115. The phone number, for information specific to the center, is (216) 687-9292.

The hiring fair is open to active duty military, National Guard and Reserve members, and spouses. A number of Cleveland-area private and public sector employers will be on hand and conducting interviews. Many of these events have already been held in cities across the country, including Columbus in March. It’s part of a nationwide effort by the Chamber to partner with local entities and encourage the business community to hire veterans.

Other Ohio and local sponsors include the Greater Cleveland Partnership and MAGNET, the Cuyahoga County Veterans Service Commission, the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services, the Ohio Department of Veterans Services, Cleveland State University, AMVETS, the Department of Labor's Veterans' Employment and Training Service (DOL VETS), the Ohio Committee of the Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve (ESGR), and NBC News.

Advanced registration is strongly encouraged. Job-seekers should bring a current resume and be dressed professionally.
