**Background:** Ohio is proud to be called home to approximately 900,000 veterans and military service members. - **Link Veterans to Employers:** The Veterans Business Support Center – accessible at [OhioMeansJobs.com](http://OhioMeansJobs.com) – connects employers to qualified veterans for free.
- **Support Ohio's Veterans:** Veterans receive priority of service across the state's workforce system and veteran resumes are prioritized on [OhioMeansJobs.com](http://OhioMeansJobs.com), allowing employers to review these first when looking for perspective employees.
- **Attract Veterans to Ohio:** [OhioMeansVeteranJobs.com](http://OhioMeansVeteranJobs.com) provides a single point of entry for veterans seeking information about employment, education and financial benefits available in Ohio.
